## 18<sup>th</sup> Annual CyberPsychology and CyberTherapy Conference

Brussels, Belgium ---- The Interactive Media Institute (IMI) and Virtual Reality Medical Institute will host the 18th Annual CyberPsychology and CyberTherapy (CYBER18) Conference: Connecting Healthcare and Technology in Brussels, Belgium, June 30-July 2, 2013. CYBER18 is the official conference of the International Association of CyberPsychology, Training, & Rehabilitation (iACToR). The event attracts clinicians and researchers from around the world who are using innovative technologies to provide more effective applications for the diagnosis, assessment, and treatment of mental and physical disorders. The conference features

presentations by researchers employing interactive technologies for training, mental health, disabilities, and rehabilitation. Several of the presenters will be introducing cutting-edge technologies, such as shared virtual worlds, avatars, videogame virtual reality, and noninvasive physiological monitoring in virtual worlds.
